UEA 2016 LEGISLATIVE VOTING RECORD SUMMARY

SENATE BILLS

SB 2 (Lyle Hillyard) PUBLIC EDUCATION BUDGET AMENDMENTS
UEA's Position: Support House Floor Amendment 2 *Passed in the House and Senate; Amendment 2 Failed*
SB 2 provides funding for new student growth and a four percent increase on the WPU.

SB 38 S4 (Howard Stephenson) SCHOOL FUNDING AMENDMENTS
UEA's Position: Oppose *Passed in the House and Senate*
SB 38 creates a state charter levy, providing an additional \$20 million in funding for charter schools.

SB 45 S3 (Alvin Jackson) COMPULSORY EDUCATION REVISIONS
UEA's Position: Oppose *Passed in the Senate; Failed in the House; Filed*
SB 45 eliminates criminal penalties for the parent of a truant school-age child.

SB 67 (Ann Millner) PARTNERSHIPS FOR STUDENT SUCCESS
UEA's Position: Support *Passed in the House and Senate*
SB 67 creates the Partnerships for Student Success Grant Program. It amends and enacts provisions regarding partnerships focused on student success.

SB 78 (Ann Millner) STATE BOARD OF EDUCATION CANDIDATE SELECTION
UEA's Position: Oppose *Passed in the House and Senate*
SB 78 creates a non-partisan State Board of Education primary in 2016 and partisan elections thereafter.

SB 87 (Howard Stephenson) ADMINISTRATIVE RULEMAKING ACT MODIFICATIONS
UEA's Position: Oppose *Passed in the House and Senate; Governor Vetoed*
SB 87 exempts the State Board of Education from certain public hearing requirements described in the Utah Administrative Rulemaking Act.

SB 165 (Howard Stephenson) PUBLIC EDUCATION APPOINTMENT AND HIRING
UEA's Position: Oppose *Passed in the Senate; Held in House Committee; Filed*
SB 165 gives the principal final authority on who will be hired in their building.

SB 244 S2 (Lincoln Fillmore) SCHOOL FUNDING PROVISIONS
UEA's Position: Oppose *Passed in the Senate; Not Heard in the House; Filed*
SB 244 attempts to equalize the property tax funding statewide over time by earmarking a portion of any new education funding.
