UEA 2017 LEGISLATIVE VOTING RECORD SUMMARY

SENATE BILLS

- SB 49 (Lincoln Fillmore)** PURPOSE OF MINIMUM SCHOOL PROGRAM
UEA's Position: Oppose *Passed in the Senate; Failed in House Committee*
SB 49 changes the Minimum School Program Act to refer to “each child” rather than “all children,” which could lead to voucher-like schemes.
- SB 78 (Ann Millner)** TEACHER PEDAGOGICAL ASSESSMENT
UEA's Position: Oppose *Passed in the Senate; Failed in House Committee*
SB 78 requires a test before receiving a teaching license – educators graduating from a university preparation program must pass the test prior to being licensed while educators in an alternate route program have up to two years in a classroom before they must pass the test.
- SB 80 (Lincoln Fillmore)** SCHOOL FUNDING AMENDMENTS
UEA's Position: Oppose *Passed in the Senate; then combined with SB 255*
SB 80 attempts to equalize funding to qualifying school districts.
- SB 161 (Luz Escamilla)** BULLYING AND HAZING AMENDMENTS
UEA's Position: Support *Passed in the House and Senate*
SB 161 requires school boards to update policy regarding bullying, cyber-bullying, hazing and retaliation.
- SB 196 (Stuart Adams)** HEALTH EDUCATION AMENDMENTS
UEA's Position: Support *Passed in the House and Senate*
SB 196 repeals language prohibiting the advocacy of homosexuality in health instruction in public schools.
- SB 220 (Ann Millner)** STUDENT ASSESSMENT AND SCHOOL ACCOUNTABILITY AMENDMENTS
UEA's Position: Oppose w/comment *Passed in the House and Senate*
SB 220 would improve the school accountability system by reporting a dashboard of school indicators and requiring ACT assessment for high school. It was amended to skip grading schools for the 2017-2018 year only.
