UEA 2018 LEGISLATIVE VOTING RECORD SUMMARY

SENATE VOTE BILLS

HB 57 (John Westwood)

UEA's Position: Support

HB 57 enacts a state earned income tax credit.

UTAH INTERGENERATIONAL POVERTY WORK
AND SELF-SUFFICIENCY TAX CREDIT

Passed in the House and Senate/Filed.

HB 132 S4 (Lowry Snow)

UEA's Position: Support

HB 132 S4 clarifies the duties of school resource officers and examines reasons students are referred to the juvenile system for truancy.

JUVENILE JUSTICE MODIFICATIONS

Passed in the House and Senate.

HB 233 S4 (Val Potter)

UEA's Position: Oppose Sub 4

HB 233 S4 removes the teacher salary supplement from compensation calculations for retirement purposes.

TEACHER SALARY SUPPLEMENT REVISIONS

*Passed in the House and House and Senate Ed
Committees.*

HB 264 (Steve Eliason)

UEA's Position: Support w/Comment

HB 264 creates a grant program for low-income elementary schools to hire a counselor or social worker for school-based mental health supports.

ELEMENTARY SCHOOL COUNSELOR PROGRAM

Passed in the House and Senate.

HB 293 S5 (Brad Last)

UEA's Position: Support

HB 293 S5 equalizes property tax funding for schools using new property tax revenue and adds a new increment on the basic rate indexed to the WPU.

TAX REBALANCING REVISIONS

Passed in the House and Senate.

HB 313 S3 (Dan McCay)

UEA's Position: Oppose

HB 313 S3 allows charter school authorizers to finalize school approvals, removing the elected State Board of Education from the approval process.

PUBLIC SCHOOL REVISIONS

Passed in the House and Senate.

HJR 20 S1 (Becky Edwards)

UEA's Position: Support

HJR 20 S1 places a question on the November 2018 ballot asking voters if they support a ten cent per gallon gas tax to provide for new education funding.

JOINT RESOLUTION SUBMITTING A QUESTION TO VOTERS

Passed in the House and Senate.

SB 95 S1 (Jani Iwamoto)

UEA's Position: Support

SB 95 S1 modifies the Postretirement Reemployment Restrictions Act by amending provisions relating to postretirement reemployment for educators.

EDUCATOR POSTRETIREMENT REEMPLOYMENT
AMENDMENTS

*Passed in the Senate and Senate Ed
Committee/Filed.*

SB 145 S2 (Lincoln Fillmore)

UEA's Position: Oppose

SB 145 S2 equalizes property tax funding for schools using existing revenue.

SCHOOL FUNDING REVISIONS

Passed in the House and Senate.

SENATE VOTE BILLS, CONTINUED

SB 194 S1 (Ann Millner)

UEA's Position: Support

SB 194 S1 amends provisions related to a program for early literacy.

EARLY LITERACY PROGRAM

Passed in the House and the Senate.

SJR 16 (Jim Dabakis)

UEA's Position: Oppose

SJR 16 replaces the State Board of Education with a superintendent appointed by the Governor and approved by the Senate.

PROPOSAL TO AMEND CONSTITUTION –
PUBLIC EDUCATION GOVERNANCE

Passed in the Senate. Failed in the House.
