



2024 LEGISLATIVE VOTING RECORD SUMMARY

The Utah Education Association (UEA) tracked numerous bills during the 2024 legislative session. This summary highlights several bills that could have a significant impact on public education and educators. It is important to note that a voting record is but one of several indicators used to evaluate legislators.

HOUSE BILLS

HB 29 Sub 2 (Rep. K. Ivory)

Sensitive Material Review Amendments

UEA's Position: Oppose

Passed the House and the Senate

Creates a review process for “objective” and “subjective” sensitive materials and requires a statewide ban on any material at least three school districts remove.

HB 173 Sub 1 (Rep. C. Pierucci)

Local School Board Amendments

UEA's Position: Oppose

Not heard in the Senate committee

This bill addresses actions of a school district that may be subject to a referendum.

HB 192 Sub 3 (Rep. M.G. Ballard)

Local Education Agency Employee Paid Leave

UEA's Position: Support

Passed the House and the Senate

Requires school districts to provide parental leave and postpartum leave for employees.

HB 221 Sub 1 (Rep. K. Peterson)

Stipends for Future Educators

UEA's Position: Support

Passed the House and the Senate

Creates a grant program to pay education students during the student teaching semester.

HB 251 (Rep. M. Gwynn)

Postretirement Reemployment Restrictions Amendments

UEA's Position: Support

Passed the House and the Senate

Allows a retiree within the Utah Retirement System to return to work with a participating URS employer after 90 days.

HB 257 Sub 5 (Rep. K. Birkeland)

Sex--based Designations for Privacy, Anti--bullying, and Women's Opportunities

UEA's Position: Oppose

Passed the House and the Senate

Creates restrictions on the use of sex-designated bathrooms, locker rooms and showers in public schools.

HB 261 Sub 4 (Rep. K. Hall)

Equal Opportunity Initiatives

UEA's Position: Oppose

Passed the House and the Senate

Prohibits higher education, K-12 public schools and government employers from certain diversity, equity and inclusion practices.



2024 LEGISLATIVE VOTING RECORD SUMMARY

HB 269 Sub 1 (Rep. M. Petersen) Public School History Curricula Amendments

UEA's Position: Oppose

Passed the House and the Senate

Adds "The Ten Commandments" and the Magna Carta to a list of historical documents and principles that may be studied in public school American history and government classes.

HB 285 Sub 2 (Rep. J. Teuscher) Public Sector Labor Organizations Amendments

UEA's Position: Oppose

Not heard in the House

Restricts public employer labor groups from payroll deduction of dues, limits access to public property and requires recertification every five years.

HB 303 Sub1 (Rep. J. Stenquist) School Curriculum Requirements

UEA's Position: Oppose

Failed in the House

Prohibits school employees from endorsing, promoting, or disparaging certain beliefs or viewpoints.

HB 347 Sub 3 (Rep. R. Ward) Educational Rights Amendments

UEA's Position: Support

Passed the Senate and the House

Requires public schools to provide an educational environment that is safe for all educators, staff and students and to ensure the educational environment has minimal disruptions for all.

HB 514 (Rep. K. Stratton) School Chaplain Amendments

UEA's Position: Oppose

Failed in the Senate

Allows public schools to have volunteer school chaplains.

SENATE BILLS

SB 69 (Sen. C. Wilson) Income Tax Amendments

UEA's Position: Oppose

Passed the Senate and the House

Reduces the state income tax rate from 4.65% to 4.55%

SB 137 Sub 1 (Sen. L. Fillmore) Teacher Empowerment

UEA's Position: Support

Passed the Senate and the House

Amends provisions related to educator evaluations.

SB 173 Sub 3 (Sen. L. Fillmore) Market Informed Compensation for Teachers

UEA's Position: Oppose

Passed the House and the Senate

Turns over the state-defined Teacher Salary Supplement Program to districts to define high-needs areas; creates a bonus program for educators in the top 25% of educators in the state.
