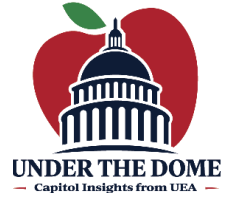




How A Bill Becomes A Law



At the Utah State Legislature
a bill is introduced in the
House or the **Senate**

**Assigned to House
Standing Committee**



**Standing Committee
hearing and vote**



House Debate and Vote.

**Once passed, the bill is
sent to the **Senate**.**

Any changes
made to a
bill must be
approved by
the originating
chamber.

House and
Senate must pass
the same version
of the final bill
for it to move
forward.



The Bill is then
sent to the Gov.
to sign into law
or veto.

**Assigned to Senate
Standing Committee**



**Standing Committee
hearing and vote**
