UEA 2019 LEGISLATIVE VOTING RECORD SUMMARY

SENATE VOTE BILLS

SB 149 (Ann Millner)

UEA's Position: Oppose

SB 149 creates a new funding distribution system and requires each school to create an "outcome-based program plan" to access the money.

TEACHER AND STUDENT SUCCESS ACT

Passed in the House and Senate.

SB 177 (Lincoln Fillmore)

UEA's Position: Oppose

SB 177 creates a new voucher program to redirect public money to private schools and requires the State Board to oversee the program.

SCHOLARSHIPS FOR SPECIAL NEEDS STUDENTS

Passed in the Senate but not heard in the House.

SB 236 (Ann Millner)

UEA's Position: Oppose

SB 236 allows State Board of Education candidates to run as a partisan candidate, unaffiliated candidate or write-in candidate.

STATE BOARD OF EDUCATION CANDIDACY AMENDMENTS

Passed in the House and Senate.
