SENATE VOTE BILLS

SB 62 S4 (Lincoln Fillmore)

UEA's Position: Oppose

SPECIAL NEEDS OPPORTUNITY SCHOLARSHIP PROGRAM
AMENDMENTS

Passed in the Senate and in the House.

Extends the special needs voucher program to non-special needs siblings of scholarship recipient students.

SB 114 S1 (Lincoln Fillmore)

UEA's Position: Oppose

PUBLIC SCHOOL CURRICULUM REQUIREMENTS

Passed in Committee; Not heard in the Senate.

Requires a standardized process for districts and charter schools to approve curriculum and classroom materials.

SB 127 S1 (Ann Millner)

UEA's Position: Support w/comments

EARLY LITERACY OUTCOMES IMPROVEMENT

Passed in the Senate and in the House.

Creates a statewide, comprehensive approach to early literacy instruction.

SJR 3 S1 (Dan McCay)

UEA's Position: Oppose

JOINT RESOLUTION TO TERMINATE PUBLIC HEALTH ORDERS
PERTAINING TO FACE COVERINGS

Passed in the Senate and in the House.

Terminates public health orders of constraint requiring the wearing of a mask or face covering.
